

We're excited to share that our school has received several generous grants and donations to support learning and play:

Aotearoa Gaming Trust has contributed \$4,947.00 funding towards our swimming costs for Term three swimming to support lessons and buses.

Otago Community Trust has granted us \$2,220 to support our new sandpit development.

NZCT has granted \$5000 towards purchasing new readers for classroom and home reading.

Our wonderful PTA has also donated **\$12,000** towards new reading books and teacher aide time to support learners across the school. We are so grateful to fund a Teacher aide in every classroom.
